



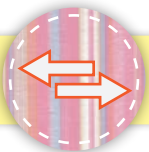
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# Introduction to Exam Skills

To find out something in the text/question which is a kind of a specific thing in the question/text.

## Making a reference

To find something in the text that belongs to the same group as one of the options.

**3**

## Understanding connection between ideas

To find the relationship (e.g. cause and effect) between one thing in the question and another thing in the text.

**4**

## Guessing the meaning of unfamiliar words

To guess the meaning of unfamiliar words in the text by paying attention to words around them.

**5**

## Analysing the information

To gather information from different parts of the text and then check if each option is correct or not.
